劳发局与烹饪训练学院 设“新技能资格厨艺奖学金”

去年推出的厨艺奖学金反应热烈，劳动力发展局与烹饪训练学院at-sunrice今年拨款436万元，另外设立250份“新技能资格厨艺奖学金”(WSQ Culinary Scholarship)。

劳发局与at-sunrice昨天发表联合声明宣布这项消息。每名奖学金得主将能获得总值1万3800元的奖学金，在at-sunrice修读“糕点与烘焙专业文凭”或“厨艺与卓越服务专业文凭”。学员在受训期间，还能获得本地名厨指导。

为了鼓励更多人加入厨师的行列，劳发局从去年起，与厨艺界联合发展一套培训课程，并提供高达80%的津贴，计划每年培训500名厨师，以配合饮食业的发展。去年，劳发局与at-sunrice一共投入140万元发出100份

厨艺奖学金，八成的申请者是有意转换跑道的专业人士、经理和执行官。

劳发局旅游事务署署长张晓云说：“餐饮业者对这项计划给予肯定，指出学员能够学以致用。我们很高兴知道，这项计划配合本地餐饮业的需要。今年，我们派发更多奖学金，吸引更多人才投入餐饮业，为蓬勃发展的餐饮业培训更多高技能专才。”

at-sunrice昨天邀请500名厨艺课程学员、培训人员和餐饮业者，在国泰戏院观赏迪斯尼动画片《料理鼠王》(Ratatouille)，电影讲述一个梦想成为厨师的老鼠的经历。

Singapore Workforce Development Authority and at-sunrice Culinary Training School sets up "WSQ Culinary Scholarship"

With the popularity of the culinary scholarships introduced last year, the WDA and at-sunrice Culinary Training School came up with S\$4,360,000 to fund another 250 WSQ Culinary Scholarships.

This was jointly announced by WDA and at-sunrice yesterday. Every scholar will receive a scholarship worth S\$13,800 to undertake the "Cakes and Baking Professional Certificate" or "Culinary and Excellent Service Professional Certificate" at at-sunrice. During training, students will receive pointers from famous chefs.

To encourage more people to join the culinary profession, starting last year WDA worked with the culinary industry to start a series of training courses, and to fund up to 80% of the course fees. WDA plans to train 500 chefs every year to match the growth of the F&B industry. Last year, WDA and at-sunrice co-funded S\$1,400,000 to issue 100 scholarships, and 80% of the applicants were professionals, managers and executives who wanted a chance of career.

WDA tourism head Zhang Xiao Yun said that F&B players expressed support of this program, and that the WDA is happy to know that it caters to the industry needs. This year, more scholarships were made available to attract more talent into the growing F&B industry.

Yesterday, at-sunrise invited 500 culinary students, trainers and industry players to watch the screening of Disney's Ratatouille at Cathay cinema. The movie is about the experiences of rat who aspires to be a chef.

Dr Amy Khor, mayor of south-west district, was the VIP for the event.
